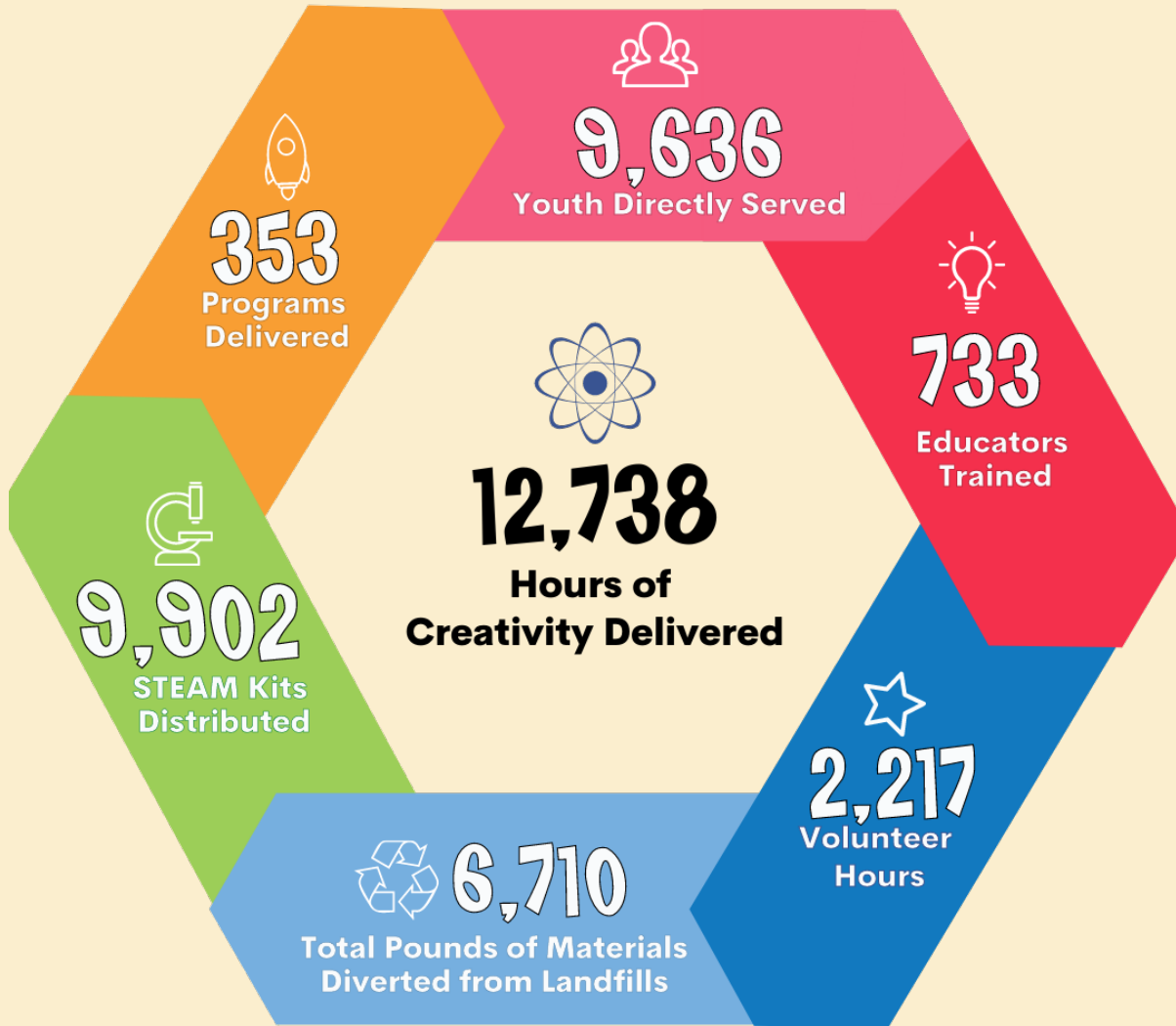
With the new year, we have a reason to celebrate:

## INVENTOR DAY at Pretend City

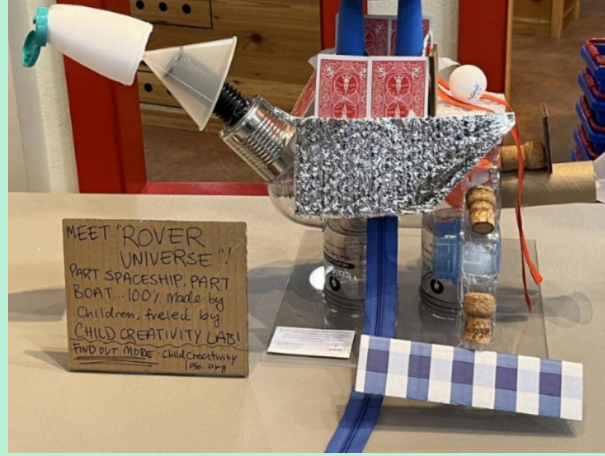


On January 30th, we celebrated
